The COVID-19 pandemic has been a difficult time for many families but as we returned to normalcy at the end last year, we resumed in-person programming and events. During the pandemic, we learned to shift into more innovative and creative forms of fundraising and programming. However, through it all, you have remained committed and supportive of all our outreach efforts. Consequently, together with our primary partner, the Broward County Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Inc., we have had two phenomenal years of community outreach through successful program initiatives, fundraising efforts, and scholarship awards.

This year we saw a significant increase in student involvement in the mentoring programs. These programs focus on improving student's leadership skills, self-efficacy, and academic achievement. Our goal is to empower the youth in this community to succeed. Through the Read America program, thousands of books were distributed to children from preschool through high school. The May Week program celebrates the academic achievement of high school students, which includes providing sessions on college readiness, hosting a college fair, and culminating in the "In Pursuit of Excellence" scholarship awards program. During this biennium, 67 students were awarded over \$187,000 in scholarships to pursue their secondary education goals.

As we extend our heartfelt thank you for your generosity and support, we ask that you continue to include DELDF in your budget, participate in our programs, and volunteer whenever possible. Your time, talent, and treasure have made all the difference in our success during this biennium. Our successes are your successes.

This year marks the end of my term as Chair of DELDF. What a remarkable, educational, and phenomenal experience! Thank you again for your support. It is imperative that we continue to work together to create a better community. This will be a WIN-WIN for DELDF, BCAC-DST and the community.





Dr. Jeanne L. Noble Delta GEMS Institute Delta GEMS was created to catch the dreams of African American at-risk, adolescent girls aged 14-18. This life-changing program has positively impacted over 76 young ladies towards academic excellence while instilling compassion for community.

Delta Academy

The Dr. Betty Shabazz Delta Academy program targets middle school girls ages 11-14. Our curriculum empowered **34 young girls** with skills and strategies to cultivate their self-esteem, intellectual, and physical development.





May Week

May Week is a national program of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. to highlight academic and professional achievement, emphasizing the importance of higher education. DELDF awarded \$187,000 scholarship dollars to 67 deserving high school seniors furthering their education.

DELDF provides accessible programming to diverse groups in support of literacy, educational development, and physical health.



Scholars Academy Scholars Academy supported over 200 high school students in Broward County with workshops covering topics including SAT/ACT prep, FAFSA and budget planning, scholarship essay writing, and discussions with first-generation college graduates. This initiative included a College Fair showcasing 18 colleges and universities.

Read America The longstanding mission of the Read America initiative is to promote literacy and a love of reading. Our programs provided over 6,700 books to 1,833 youth, helping 302 families.

The Empowering Males to Build Opportunities for Developing Independence (EMBODI) program is designed to refocus the efforts on the plight of African-American males.
